Minutes of the Governing Body Meeting of the Bombay College of Pharmacy (BCP) vide No. GB/ 285/2019 held on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> Aug 2019 from 11.00 am to 1.00pm in the Conference Room of the Bombay College of Pharmacy, Kalina, Santacruz (E), Mumbai.

Dr Anand Shedge and Prof Ukrande, University of Mumbai Nominee, requested leave of absence and the same was granted

**Welcome & Preamble to Autonomy:**

Prof. Krishnapriya Mohanraj welcomed the members of the Governing Body and Dr. N. Sivaprasad honored the UGC nominee to Governing Body Prof. Sanjay Kumar Jain by offering bouquet of flowers and memento. She mentioned that this is the second Governing Body meeting (GB) after grant of autonomy. She charted the route for autonomy at Bombay College of Pharmacy beginning with Dr. S. K. Mahajan, former Director of DTE mentioning at Governing Body meeting of Bombay College of Pharmacy in March 2014, that the college should go in for autonomy. He reiterated this at the next GB meeting in Aug 2014. It was Dr. Anand Shedge, Vice President IPA-MSB who took on the mantle of Autonomy mentor and established a one-member committee of Dr. R. S. Gaud, NMIMS university to look into whether BCP should go in for Academic autonomy. Dr. R. S. Gaud recommended going in for academic autonomy and the ball was set rolling.

Dr. Krihnapriya Mohanraj appreciated the efforts put in by Dr. Anand Shedge – Mentor for Autonomy, the coordinator & co-coordinator of autonomy, Dr. Anuradha Majumdar and Dr. Vaishali Shirsat, respectively, Prof. Evans Coutinho, Prof. Krishna Iyer and Dr. Anand Chintakrindi who streamlined the autonomy application and the team of faculty, administration and accounts staff and Ph. D students led by Dr. Dipti Gatne in keeping the documentation for the autonomy inspection ready. She thanked

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Chairman, Governing Body, Mr. Nitin Maniar and President IPA-MSB, Dr. N. Sivaprasad for their inputs & support. Dr. Krishnapriya Mohanraj informed that the autonomy application was sent in Nov 2018, the inspection took place in March 2019 by the expert committee of Prof. Sanjay Kumar Jain, Head, Dept. of Pharmaceutical Sciences-Sagar University- Chairperson, Prof. B. Narasimhanan, Dean, DRS Dept. of Pharmaceutical Science, M. D University-Rohtak, Dr. Rama Rao Nadendla, Principal-Chalapathi Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences (Autonomous), Ms. S. Bhanumati, Section Officer, UGC, Mr. Pramod Naik, Joint Director, Directorate of Technical Education, DTE Nominee, Dr. Shreerang Joshi, University Nominee, Head Dept. of Pharmaceutical Sciences & Technology, ICT. UGC sent the letter for conferment of autonomy for 10 years in May 2019 and the letter from University of Mumbai confirming granting of autonomous status to BCP was received on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2019. This was one of the fastest conferment of autonomous according to the UGC coordinator.

Once the conferment was granted under the chairmanship of Prof. Coutinho, a steering committee for autonomy was constituted wherein Prof. S. K. Kulkarni former Director of BCP & former Pro Vice Chancellor of Punjab University gave his expert inputs at meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019. A scheme for B. Pharm with one semester of practice school just like BITS, Pilani was planned. But PCI put up a public notice that under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948, the Pharmacy Council of India grants approval to pharmacy courses and examinations for the purpose of registration as a pharmacist to practice the profession under the Pharmacy Act. The PCI approves the pharmacy courses of B. Pharm and M. Pharm under the statutory Provision of the Education Regulations framed under section 10 of the Pharmacy Act. viz. The Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) Course Regulations 2014, and Master of Pharmacy (M. Pharm) Course regulations 2014. Considering this public notice and the fact that all other institutes except ICT has implemented PCI syllabus, including institutions affiliated to University of Mumbai, it was decided in meeting of Prof. Coutinho, I/c Principal, Vice Principals and Heads of Departments that BCP should implement PCI Syllabus for B. Pharm and continue with University of Mumbai syllabus for M. Pharm. The latter was also decided during steering committee meeting.

It was resolved that PCI B. Pharm syllabus would be implemented from academic year 2019-20 for First Year B Pharm. Meanwhile letters and emails have been sent to Secretary PCI and President PCI to grant permission to implement own syllabus since it is a mandatory regulation under UGC guidelines for autonomous colleges 2018 to have own syllabus.

It was also resolved that at Bombay College of Pharmacy, even though we will be following PCI Syllabus, we will implement higher teaching learning strategies and evaluation techniques which will make the course unique to BCP.

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In connection with autonomy, meetings with Dr. Rajendra Shinde, Principal, St. Xavier autonomous college and Dr. M. Murudi, Vice Principal of Sardar Patel Engineering College(autonomous) were conducted and Dr. K. M acknowledged their inputs in understanding implementation of autonomous status. She also acknowledged the help of Dr. Shashi Menon, Professor and Dr. Anushree Lokur, Principal, Ruia College (Autonomous) for their clarifications & inputs w.r.t recognition of Post Graduate guides and fee structure respectively.




