Sir,

This has reference to your letter No. BCP/Univ./Ph.D./5/2003, dated 17th April, 2003, requesting therein permission for permanent recognition and also to increase the intake capacity respectively for the Master of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Ph.D. degree course in the subjects of Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmacognosy and Pharmacology of the University.

In this connection, I write to inform you that the report of the committee for permanent recognition and also to increase the intake capacity respectively to enroll the students for M.Pharm.Sc. and Ph.D. course in the subjects of Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmacognosy and Pharmacology of the University was considered by Board of University Teaching and Research (B.U.T.R.) for the faculty of Technology at its meeting held on 11th May, 2005, vide item No. 07, when it was resolved as under :-

"Resolved that the report of Local Inquiry Committee be accepted and it be recommended to the Academic council that Principal Bombay College of Pharmacy, Mumbai, be granted permanent recognition w.e.f. 2005-2006, to enroll 33 (Thirty Three) students for M.Pharm.Sc. in the following branches.

to enroll not more than 35 (Thirty Five) students at given time for Ph.D.(Tech.) in the field of Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmacognosy & Pharmacology taken together subject to fulfillment of the following conditions.

1. The college shall spend at least Rs. 10,000/- per students per year for smooth conduct of the research work.
2. The college should spend at least 2.00 (Two Lacks) per year exclusively for textbook and reference books exclusively for M. Pharmaceutical Sciences.
3. The admission process shall be done as per the university norms.
4. The facility at the college hall be made available to the other students of the University of Mumbai.
5. The college shall provide stipend to the students enrolled/registered.
6. The recognised teacher of the college shall contribute in Postgraduate teaching programme of the University of Mumbai and make their services available for conduction University examinations wherever required.

The above recommendation were accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 14th June, 2005, vide item No. 2.1.


